<u>Black Swan Cabernet Franc 2002</u> BRONZE medal winner Perth Show 03/04/05 Made from a variety of fruit with limited supply and harvested from our vines, has produced a Cabernet Franc of ruby red with a bright purple hue of medium intensity. Lifted vanilla oak with an overlay of blackcurrant, plum and raspberry fruits extended to the palate.	180ml \$14	\$52
<u>Black Swan Cabernet Franc 2005</u> SILVER medal winner Swan Valley Wine Show 2006 This vintage has produced a wine which is a bright plum colour with a soft purple hue infused with a lifted bouquet of black currant, spicy cloves and pepper. The palate has a masculine intensity exhibiting generous fruit flavours balanced by harmonious grape and oak tannins.	\$10	\$36
<u>Black Swan Cabernet Sauvignon 2004</u> BRONZE medal winner Swan Valley Wine Show 2005 An Intense purple/red with bright hues, a seductive bouquet of rich berry fruits and integrated vanilla oak characters. Smooth fruit driven wine with concentrated characters of blackberries and a hint of liquorice.	\$8	\$28
<u>Black Swan Cabernet Merlot 2004</u> BRONZE medal winner Swan Valley Wine Show 2006 A Cabernet Merlot exhibiting rich earthy characters and a hint of raspberry fruit. Combined with a silky smooth palate and long lingering taste of spice with a soft peppery finish.	\$9	\$32
<u>Black Swan Shiraz 2004</u> This Shiraz in its second year of maturity is a deep ruby red colour. It displays lifted spice and cinnamon with hints of plum and raspberry on the nose and a palate left with a lingering finish of spicy black pepper.	\$8	\$26
<u>Black Swan Rose 2005</u> BRONZE medal winner Swan Valley Wine Show 2005 Raspberry red Rose with brilliant hues and lifted berry fruits exhibits up front fruit sweetness. The palate has a wonderful soft acidity balanced by the full flavours of Cabernet fruit.	\$7	\$24
<u>Talijancich Graciano 2003</u> Matured in New French oak, this full bodied dry red displays characteristics of blackcurrant and liquorice. A short length with a lingering finish.		\$49
<u>Clifford Bay (NZ) Pinot Noir 2006</u> Produced from premium quality Awatere Valley grapes, grown in the renowned Marlborough region. Vibrant black cherry notes balanced with spicy French Oak		\$42.50
<u>The Black Chook Sparkling Shiraz</u> This non vintage wine sparkles to the tune of a well balanced blend; Predominantly 3 year old Shiraz, aged in old French oak barrels showing wonderful smooth integrated fruit and a rich weighty texture across the palate		\$36
