Black Swan Late Harvest 2005

Bronze medal winner Swan Valley Wine Show 2006
A wine that exhibits lively, intense lifted fruit flavours. A natural sweetness evident on the palate with crisp citrus characters.

Black Swan Classic White 2004

Produced from Chenin, off 60 year old vines. Prevalent aromas of guava and lime on the Nose and a palate of topical fruits with a clean crisp finish.

Bronze medal winner Swan Valley Wine Show 2005
A wine with an elegant bouquet of peach and lime citrus, overlaid with a soft buttery note. A smooth palate with rich melon flavours and balanced by a zesty fresh finish.

Talijancich Verdelho 2003 (Swan Valley)

On the nose expect to find lifted fruits of guava and melon with herbaceous undertones, whilst on the palate, a generous length and a clean crisp finish.
